## President's Letter by Vicki Nelson

Dear MEOW Members:

It is time once again to catch you up on a few things that have been happening within the MEOW organization.

You may or may not have heard rumors that there will be no Seminar 2011 due to the economy and too expensive of a facility to hold the seminar. It was decided that I was to appoint several members to be on a committee to pursue other less expensive facilities. If the costs go down then maybe more members would attend. For the past several years only about 25% of our membership attend the seminars. If any of you have suggestions about any of this please feel free to contact me. I will be appointing the committee members on or before September 1st, which starts MEOW's fiscal year. If anyone would like to be on this committee, let me know.

Another change which was made by the Board, was to decline participation in the Spring Sew Expo. It was costing MEOW between \$500.00 and \$700.00 to rent the booth along with electricity and flyers. We are not getting much of a return on our investment when we only recruit one or two new members. Last year we needed at least 40 volunteers to help work in the booth, but we only had 25. Setting up the booth, doing demos, handing out flyers and tearing the booth down were falling on the same members each year. Another factor was that there was a possibility that the Expo was going to increase the hours from 8 am—8:30 pm Thursday through Sunday. It was a hard decision to make because once we say no; we won't get back in again as there is a long waiting list of vendors who would like to participate. We are going to continue to have a booth at the Northwest Quilting and Craft Show in November. The only costs incurred are for electricity and flyers. This show is only 3 days, Thursday, Friday and Saturday from 10 am to 5 pm.

I always enjoy myself when I am at seminar because I can see friends from other groups who I only see once a year. I also get to make new friends amongst those newbie's who come to seminar. I did not participate in the apron challenge or the ATC's (Artist Trading Cards) this year, but from what I saw that night, everyone was having a good time. I do have 3 ATC's to make as a few members gave me one of theirs. If you are into this sort of thing, maybe look in the roster and pick someone you don't know and send her one and tell her a little bit about yourself and ask her to respond back.

Another thing on my agenda is to pick three (3) members who are not on the Board to be on the nominating committee for the election which will be held at the new general meeting which is usually done at Seminar. Since there will not be a Seminar, the new officers will be installed at the July Board meeting. Next year, the Membership needs to vote on the Vice President, Secretary and four (4) State Directors. So if someone calls you from the nominating committee to run for a Board position, please give it some thought as it is a great way to learn about the in's and out's of what happens at these meetings.

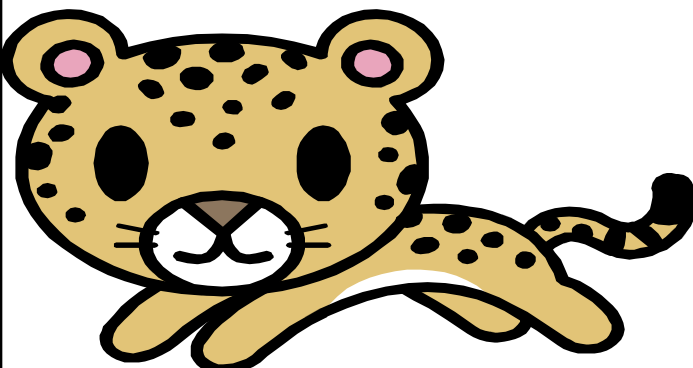

**Vice-President's Report** – New assignments were made to the Director's as to their area groups for the 2010 – 2011 year. They will be announced in the October newsletter. We have a new group in Sunnyside, which will meet at the Quality Delights Quilt Shop and will be learning about embroidery software. **Community Service Reports are requested of the Area Reps on a monthly basis.** A reminder that all final Community Service reports from Area Groups will be due on September 30<sup>th</sup>. There is a new form under Publications and Forms on the Website that will allow you to fill in the blanks. Area Reps please remind your members to send out their thank you notes from the Seminar Raffle.

**Secretary's Report** – The minutes from the January Board meeting were reported in the last newsletter.

**Sunshine Report** – There was no report. It was suggested by a new member that we leave out the reason for the card.

**Director's Reports:** **Nancy Shepherd** announced that the **Country Kitties** are having a workshop on September 20, 21 and 22, the cost is \$100 per person for three (3) days, which includes lunch, kit fees and the class (see the information in the newsletter).

**Membership: Sandy Radtke** reported that we now have 211 total members with 21 renewals. She will be sending out reminder postcards on the 1<sup>st</sup> of August. She is going to need to print 50 new membership packets, which will cost \$125.00 and asked for a \$100 advance. This is the event that charges admission for the first visit and free for any additional days. The times are 10:00 am to 5:00 pm and the entrance fee is \$8.00 for Puyallup.

There will be **NO 2011 Spring Fair for MEOW** as the cost and benefits derived from said attendance are too high. The cost is \$500.00 +, very few signups to volunteer and we only picked up two new members this year.

**Seminar 2010:** A survey was taken from the attendees and **Nancy Howard** only received fourteen (14) back. Comments made: they liked the ATC exchange, there was no group activity set up for Saturday evening, it was too expensive and the hotel was also too expensive. Some members felt it would be okay to pay for a printed copy of the Seminar brochure if it was \$6-7.00. The Seminar made \$533.00 this year and we have \$846.55 in the raffle fund.

**Seminar 2011:** There was a long discussion about having a seminar in 2011. Because of the economic problems we are having, the opinion that the seminar is too expensive as is the facility and only an average of 25% of our membership attends, **Apral Harrel** moved that we not have a seminar in 2011 and that we refer the discussion to a committee appointed by the President consisting of:

- Charter Member
- 10 year or more attendee at seminar
- 1st time attendee
- Past Seminar Chair
- Stray Cat
- Secretary (to take notes)
- Current Seminar Chair - Nancy Howard if she is willing to do it again next time.
- Someone who has never attended seminar
- Anyone else the president feels is appropriate.

This committee would review our policies and procedures concerning Seminar and make recommendations to the board and find an appropriate facility and time.

Submitted by **Apral Harrel** 7/24/10 If we did not have a 2011 seminar, it would give the Board of Directors time to look into the suggestions that were presented to Nancy Howard and it would give the economy time to recover by 2012. The vote was 6 Yes and 3 NO and 2 Abstained. **There will be no 2011 Seminar.**

We talked about the possibility of making the offices of President and Treasurer more than a two year term as it takes more than a year just to become familiar with the position. **Sandy Radtke** made a motion that we leave things as they are for now and **Jyll Jones** seconded the motion. The vote was 8 Yes and 1 No and 2 Abstained

Now that we have only four (4) directors in Oregon and Washington, the next election will make it so that we will have two directors elected on even years and 2 on the odd year in each state.

#### OLD BUSINESS:

No action needed to be made on the Board of Directors Standing Rules.

The Stray Cats will be contacted on a monthly basis, which will make it easier for them to report

We discussed how to handle the voting and counting ballots for new officers, if one of the nomination committee happens to also be running for office. It was brought up that we could have an alternate on stand-by. This will be discussed further at a later time.

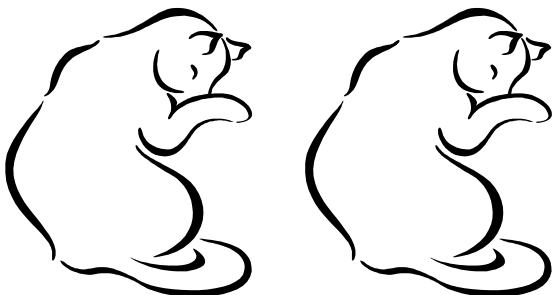
